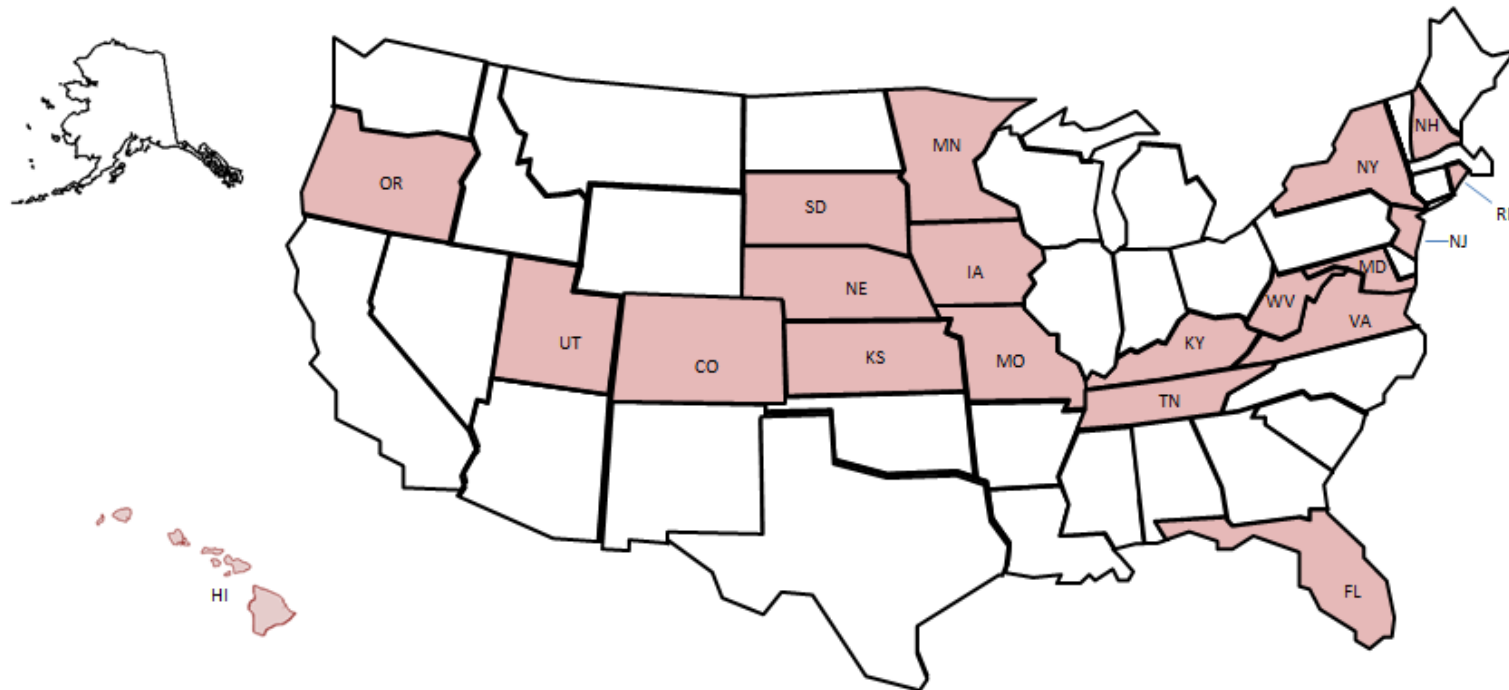


Fighting Back After *Whiting*

States That Said “No” to Mandatory E-Verify Bills (2012 Session)



This graphic depicts states that voted down bills mandating the use of E-Verify as of July 2012, with the majority of legislatures in recess. Only one state—Pennsylvania—passed a bill (Act No. 127, formerly [Senate Bill 637](#)) requiring some employers to use E-Verify. Louisiana also passed an E-Verify mandate, but this bill largely amended currently existing law and was not a significant expansion. It is also worth noting that some of the states delineated above already have existing E-Verify mandates and voted down attempts to broaden those state laws.
