





Dear Chairman Grassley:

Thank you for your October 1, 2015 letter. Secretary Johnson asked that I respond on his behalf.

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) adjudication involves extensive background and security checks for each Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) requestor during the initial and renewal request processes. Those background and security checks include research of potentially derogatory TECS records discovered during the biographic checks as well as the discovery and review of possible criminal activity history upon review of the requestor's biometric checks.

As noted in my August 24 response to your previous letter, USCIS has also been working to ensure that it receives notification when a recipient of DACA is arrested as part of a U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) investigation. USCIS recently instituted two new procedures to ensure that such notification occurs.



Thank you for your October 1, 2015 letter. Secretary Johnson asked that I respond on his behalf.

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) adjudication involves extensive background and security checks for each Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) requestor during the initial and renewal request processes. Those background and security checks include research of potentially derogatory TECS records discovered during the biographic checks as well as the discovery and review of possible criminal activity history upon review of the requestor's biometric checks.

As noted in my August 24 response to your previous letter, USCIS has also been working to ensure that it receives notification when a recipient of DACA is arrested as part of a U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) investigation. USCIS recently instituted two new procedures to ensure that such notification occurs.

In September, USCIS developed a notification procedure for when a DACA recipient is arrested and the criminal history information is uploaded to relevant databases, including the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Criminal Master File and the Department of Homeland Security Automated Biometric Identification System (known as IDENT). This process captures new arrest information discovered by biometric retrieval—specifically when a DACA recipient is arrested for a new offense. The vast majority of our Members represent communities that have been greatly impacted by your agency's broader enforcement priorities. Because of this, it is imperative that our Members receive written responses to the questions below. Since the launch of these broader enforcement efforts, the communities we represent have expressed confusion, apprehension and unease. It is critical that DHS provide clarity on these new efforts so that we can provide our constituents with the correct information regarding DHS's expanded immigration enforcement efforts.

I look forward to receiving your agency's detailed responses. Please do not hesitate to contact CHC Executive Director Alma Acosta if you have any questions.

## **QUESTIONS**

## I. ENFORCEMENT:

- 1) Of the estimated 11.3 million undocumented immigrants living in the United States today, how many do you believe are now priorities for removal according to the Department of Homeland Security?
- 2) As a candidate, President Trump repeatedly stated that "everyone here illegally must go" and on February 21, 2017, White House Press Secretary Sean Spicer stated, "If you are in this country in an illegal manner, then obviously, there is a provision that could ensure that you be removed." The recent implementation memo issued by General Kelly, "Enforcement of the Immigration Laws to Serve the National Interest," identifies a set of priorities so broad that it could encompass every single one of the 11.3 million undocumented immigrants in the country. The Q&A released by the Department of Homeland Security only reinforces the idea that DHS has decided to set no enforcement priorities. Specifically, with Question 5 DHS asks itself what ICE's priorities are and the answer is entirely nonresponsive. With Question 8 DHS asks itself whether the executive order eliminates ICE's enforcement priorities and the answer again is nonresponsive. Please explain who is and is not a priority for removal.
- 3) In General Kelly's memo, "Enforcement of the Immigration Laws to Serve the National Interest," he states that the Director of ICE, the Commissioner of CBP, and the Director of USCIS may, as appropriate, issue further guidance to allocate resources to prioritize enforcement actions. What steps are you taking to develop additional guidance to ensure that ICE's resources are focused on enhancing national security and public safety?
- 4) The President's recent interior EO expands the definition of criminality dramatically well beyond the previously accepted version of what constitutes a criminal. Please explain for us using numbers of those impacted how many "criminal aliens" you believe there are in the country today.
- 5) The President's interior EO stated that "we cannot faithfully execute the immigration laws of the United States if we exempt classes or categories of removable aliens from potential enforcement." How can we read this in any other way than a declaration of intent that the entire undocumented population should consider themselves on notice for removal? Do you believe fear of deportation is an important tactic and deterrent?
- 6) The memorandum, "Enforcement of the Immigration Laws to Serve the National Interest," directs DHS agencies to make full use of <u>all</u> statutory authorities for removing aliens "expeditiously." In addition to expedited removal, CAP, the Institutional Hearing and Removal Program, 238(b) removals, and other items specifically named in the memo, what else is ICE contemplating? Does this include increased use of stipulated removal orders?
- 7) The memorandum, "Implementing the President's Border Security and Immigration Enforcement Improvement Policies," states that the Department of Homeland Security will publish in the Federal

Register a designation that may alter the Department's policies with respect to the use of expedited removal.

- a) What is the expected timing for publishing this new designation in the Federal Register?
- b) There is substantial confusion in the media and among our constituents about whether changes already have been made to the Department's policies on expedited removal, or if the regulations put in place by President George W. Bush remain in place that generally limit the use of expedited removal to people apprehended within 100 air miles of the border and within 14 days of entry. Can you please confirm that no changes will be made to expedited removal unless and until a designation is made in the Federal Register?

- a) Please advise as to the current status and whereabouts of 287(g) agreements or related engagements with state and local entities and, with respect to any 287(g) agreements, the model that is not in force. ICE's website indicates that the latest 287(g) MOA was signed on 1/26/17 by the Jackson County Sheriff's Office. Have any new 287(g) agreements been signed since? Are any task force models being discussed or already in place?
- b) Please provide an accounting of all jurisdictions that have had 287(g) agreements at any point in time. For each jurisdiction, please indicate the date the agreement was initiated and the date, if any, the agreement was terminated or permitted to expire. Please also provide the type(s) of 287(g) agreement approved, including when and whether the type of agreement may have changed during the course of an agreement (e.g, from a hybrid or task force model to a jail-only model).
- c) What are the criteria that ICE is using and will continue to use when evaluating new 287(g) requests submitted by jurisdictions with past civil rights violations? Will jurisdictions with open civil rights complaints be able to participate in 287(g)?
- d) Has ICE officially terminated PEP and reinstated Secure Communities? If not, is such action contemplated? Will any changes be made to the current forms I-247N, I-247D, and I-247X? If so, we urge the agency to give the opportunity to provide comment.
- 10) <u>Parole</u>: Please provide any existing analysis or evidence of abuse of asylum and parole provisions of the INA, and if any changes are underway regarding these programs? Will ICE be issuing new parole guidance to limit the current use of parole and, if so, when?

- 12) <u>Unaccompanied Children</u>: Please provide information on what steps ICE is taking to train DHS personnel on the proper application of sections 235 of the TVPRA and 462(g)(2) of the Homeland Security Act, and to ensure compliance with the Flores settlement for all children taken into DHS custody.
- 13) Has DHS spoken with Mexico about its plan to return arriving aliens to a contiguous country to await 240 proceedings?
- 14) What date will ICE begin publishing weekly reports on "non-Federal jurisdictions" that release aliens from custody notwithstanding an ICE detainer?
- 15) Please provide an update regarding how small- and large-scale enforcement actions are currently being carried out.
- 16) Please confirm that ICE will not take enforcement actions against an applicant for adjustment of status under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act whose underlying lawful nonimmigrant status has expired or otherwise lapsed subsequent to the filing of the adjustment application and before adjudication of the application by USCIS.
- 17) Please confirm that ICE will not take enforcement actions against an applicant for adjustment of status under section 245(k) of the Immigration and Nationality Act whose application for adjustment of status was filed within 180 days past the expiration of the applicant's nonimmigrant status or violation of the terms and conditions of admission and before adjudication of the application by USCIS.
- 18) Will ICE ERO continue to adjudicate Form I-246 stay of removal applications for individuals with removal orders? Will ICE ERO detain individuals at their check-ins even if they have the I-246 application in hand ready to file? Or, will the I-246 be accepted, adjudicated, and then the individual informed of the decision along with a report date for removal to allow the opportunity to make arrangements for departure?
- 19) The new enforcement priorities reference any individual who has committed acts that constitute a "chargeable criminal offense."
  - a) What mechanisms will be put in place or are already in place to ensure that ICE officers are properly trained on state and federal criminal law in order to make such a determination?

- b) What standard will be used to determine if there is cause to include an individual within this category?
- c) Will juvenile delinquencies be considered to fall within this category?
- d) Will expunged convictions be considered to fall within this category?
- e) Will there be any prioritization of the non-ranked categories of individuals subject to enforcement listed in the EO, if so, please explain this prioritization.

#### II. DACA:

- 1) Is ICE undertaking any efforts to obtain information from USCIS regarding DACA recipients, including application information such as addresses, family information, criminal and court records, etc.? If so, how is this being accomplished, and how is ICE using this information to target DACA recipients?
- 2) Some DACA recipients fall within the newly articled enforcement priorities in the interior enforcement EO. How will such individuals be handled if encountered by ICE?
- 3) Is USCIS sharing DACA recipients' information with ICE and how is this being accomplished? How is ICE using this information to target DACA recipients?
- 4) Please provide all information related to the arrest of Mr. Daniel Medina, Daniela Ramirez and any other Dreamers detained by ICE.
- 5) Are there any additional known instances of DACA recipients detained and/or deported?
- 6) There are reports across the country that ICE HQ has advised local OCC offices to oppose all requests to administratively close proceedings in the exercise of prosecutorial discretion. Is this a formal change in policy? If so, please provide a copy of any relevant guidance or memo.

## III. DETENTION:

- 1) Given new guidance on expansion of detention and the use of expedited removal, can ICE leadership assure that the online detainee locator will remain operational?
- 2) Are there plans to build new detention sites, and if so, where will they be built and what is the timeline for building the new sites? What are the goals for expansion and how soon given the new guidelines will added capacity for detention facilities be needed?
- 3) What policies are in place to ensure that all ICE detention facilities provide adequate access to counsel including adequate attorney visitation hours without long wait times and meeting space that preserves attorney/client confidentiality?

- 4) Please provide an update on the roll-out of the 2016 PBNDS. Also, will new detention facilities all be subject to the 2016 PBNDS? Are other new detention standards being drafted or revised at this time and if so, what is the timing for their completion and to which facilities would they be applied?
- 5) Is there a schedule for PREA audits in place? If so please share.
- 6) Lawyers on the ground at the South Texas Family Residential Center (Dilley) have encountered 5 pregnant women between the last week of January and first week of February. Are the women given pregnancy tests when they enter the Dilley? Attorneys who work at Dilley report that they have notified ICE on multiple occasions that there are pregnant women in Dilley. Have there been any changes to policies or procedures regarding detaining pregnant women?
- 7) Attorneys working with detained families are aware of families who were deported without first receiving travel documents from their embassies. In some instances, we are told that they have been coerced into waiving the requirement to obtain a travel document and therefore lose an opportunity to meet with consular officials. In other instances, individuals reportedly have been deported even without signing a waiver. Can you please clarify which countries' nationals do not require consular interviews?
- 8) When will the transgender unit at the Prairieland Detention Center begin housing transgender individuals?
- 9) During the last administration ICE provided regular and timely notifications to Congress and the public regarding in-custody deaths. Will ICE continue to provide these notices?

## 10) Data requests:

- a) Please provide updates on detention statistics, including but not limited to:
  - i) How many people are in detention presently?
  - ii) Has ICE entered into any new contracts, renewed or modified contracts, and/or expanded existing capacity in facilities over the past 3 months? If so, what sites is ICE investigating for this expansion?
  - iii) In light of the anticipated expansion in detention we are concerned about ensuring access to counsel for those detained. In order to facilitate this effort we request that ICE share an updated facilities matrix on a monthly basis.

# IV. DIRECTIVES (previously issued or contemplated)

Please provide updates on the status of any previously issued directives that have already been
rescinded or that are likely to be rescinded. In particular please advise on the status of: the sensitive
locations memo; the parental interests directive; the directive regarding shackling of pregnant women;
the oversight of segregation directive; the prosecutorial discretion memo for victims and witnesses of
crimes; and the guidance regarding enforcement operations at courthouses.

- 2) Please provide a comprehensive list of all prior memos that have been rescinded in whole or in part.
- 3) Please provide any and all information relating to ICE's decision to target individuals collateral to arrests made with a warrant.
- 4) Has the USCIS NTA memo been rescinded or are there plans to rescind it?
- 5) What policies or practices are in place to guide ICE's practices on receiving tips. For instance, what actions might ICE take if a neighbor calls ICE because of a noisy party or if an alleged abuser calls ICE to report on his or her victim? Does ICE follow up on tips that provided through social media?
- 6) In 2014, the Department of Homeland Security issued guidance to ICE and CBP pertaining to enforcement actions at courthouses. Although <u>CBP's website</u> continues to contain language indicating that that guidance remains in force, <u>ICE's website</u> no longer contains that language and instead contains new language suggesting that the guidance is no longer in force. Please clarify whether the courthouse guidance issued by DHS in 2014 remains in force.
- 7) Earlier this month, ICE personnel arrested several people leaving a church hypothermia shelter. When questioned about whether the arrests violated the Department's "sensitive locations" policy, an ICE spokesperson said the policy had been followed and that the arrests took place across the street and not on church property. In light of the fact that the sensitive locations policy pertains to enforcement actions "at or near" such locations please explain how ICE interprets the words "or near" and whether that interpretation has changed in recent months.

Dear Secretary Kelly:

As we celebrate the 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the announcement of the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program on June 15<sup>th</sup>, we write to ask you to clarify the Administration's policies regarding the DACA program and on ensuring the confidentiality of those who have passed background checks and have been granted temporary protection from deportation.

As you know, DACA was announced in 2012 when the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) determined that the agency should not expend enforcement resources on young people who were brought to this country as children. DACA has been granted to over 780,000 young individuals who no longer have the fear of deportation and family separation hanging over their heads and are our newest college students, teachers, engineers and small business owners. In fact, studies have found that 92 percent of DACA recipients report that they are pursuing educational opportunities<sup>1</sup> that they previously could not and 84 percent report having a job.<sup>2</sup> Additionally, DACA recipients will add \$433.4 billion to the economy over 10 years.<sup>3</sup>

President Trump has been asked numerous times if the Administration will continue DACA. The President has responded that DACA recipients can "rest easy" and that he would "deal with DACA with heart." Your memorandum of February 20, 2017 setting forth DHS' new enforcement priorities specifically preserves the DACA program, and DHS' related FAQ reinforces that the new priorities do not apply to DACA. In testimony before the House Homeland Security Committee on June 7, you stated that your agents are not actively targeting DREAMers and those with DACA. This has not been our experience. In fact, we are concerned about the cases that have been brought to our attention where DACA recipients had their DACA revoked or, even worse, have been apprehended and detained.

Most recently, DHS revoked DACA from Jessica Colotl, a long-term resident of Georgia who was previously approved for DACA twice. A lawsuit was filed with the U.S. District Court for

the Northern District of Georgia asking that DHS reinstate Jessica's status under DACA. In a hearing on the case on June 8, government lawyers conceded that Jessica is eligible for DACA and could not provide an actual reason for why Jessica's DACA was revoked. Jessica came to the United States when she was 11-years old. She graduated from high school with honors and then earned a BA in political science. Jessica is currently working as a paralegal and continues to serve her community by volunteering for the Annual Latino Youth Leadership Conference, donating blood at the Northside Hospital in Atlanta, and fundraising for St. Jude Children's Hospital. She is exactly the type of person you describe who should not be a target for immigration enforcement.

We are greatly concerned that DACA recipients continue to be the target of immigration enforcement actions and we request that DHS fulfill its promise to these young individuals that they are protected from deportation. DACA has been a model of success and enjoys broad support from the American public across party lines.

In light of our concerns, provide the following information by July 15, 2017:

- 1. Is there currently a review of the DACA program, or is any review of the DACA program planned for the future? If so, please provide any documents on the review.
- 2. Are discussions currently underway to terminate the DACA program or amend the DACA application requirements or eligibility criteria? If so, please provide information on any new policy under consideration.
- Since January 20, 2017, has DHS adopted any new policies regarding DACA recipients, including policies that subject DACA recipients to increased review or scrutiny upon an encounter with DHS officers? If so, please provide all documents related to these policies.
- 4. The DACA instruction form (I-821D) makes clear that information provided in the application is protected from disclosure to ICE and CBP unless the requestor meets the criteria for the issuance of a Notice to Appear (NTA) or a referral to ICE under the criteria set forth in the USCIS NTA guidance. Is this still the policy of USCIS? If not, please provide information about current procedures.
- 5. On June 9, Reuters reported that DHS is re-opening hundreds of immigration cases that had previously been administratively closed.
  - Does this apply to DACA recipients? If so, are there any cases of DACA recipients that are currently under review?
  - Please provide any written policy or instructions on the review of cases under this
    policy.
- 6. Have DACA Standard Operating Procedures Changed? If so, please provide details on the new procedures.
- 7. Please provide the number of current or former DACA recipients, for each detention facility, who are in DHS custody and the detailed nature for their detention as of the date of your response to this letter.
- 8. Please provide the number, for each immigration court, of current or former DACA recipients who were put in removal proceedings between January 20, 2017 and the date of your response to this letter.

- 9. What are Border Patrol procedures for DACA recipients who present identification at a checkpoint or other encounter?
- 10. How many DACA recipients have applied for, and how many have been granted, advance parole in 2017 (by month)?
- 11. How many of those recipients who traveled were denied reentry into the United States, and for what reasons?
