## **PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

The plaintiffs having filed their Motion for Preliminary Injunction ("Motion") (Dkt. 8), the Court having read and reviewed the Motion and the briefing on said Motion, and a hearing having been conducted on November 17, 2023 at which the Court heard argument from both parties, the Court now **GRANTS** said Motion and **ORDERS** as follows:

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the defendant—as well as the defendant's officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all other persons in active concert or participation with these persons—is preliminarily enjoined from enforcing Indiana House Enrolled Act 1050 ("H.E.A. 1050") as drafted and instead shall enforce H.E.A. 1050, and all other provisions of Indiana law that reference and/or incorporate Indiana Code § 9-13-2-121.5 (or the term "parole" as defined by that statute), with the following language stricken from that definitional statute:

"Parole" means temporary legal presence in the United States under 8 U.S.C. 1182(d)(5) granted to an individual who:

(1) is a citizen or national of Ukraine or last was a habitual resident of Ukraine; and (2) meets the criteria established under Section 401(a) of the Additional Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act (Public Law 117-128) as in effect on January 1, <del>2023.</del>

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this preliminary injunction is issued without bond for the reasons stated in the Order on Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction; and the relief Ordered shall take immediate effect.
